

I have the right to a name and a nationality.


My name is Mark.

I love the sea and all that is in it.




I have the right to be part of a group and to be active in my community.

It's a good feeling to know that my opinions and ideas are valued and that I can participate in making decisions.




But... I cannot enjoy my rights if I am abused in any way: physically, mentally, emotionally or sexually.


Adults must protect us children from all forms of abuse and exploitation.


